The webinar was inaugurated at the auspicious hands of Hon. Prin. Dr. Vitthal Shivankar, Secretary, Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara and Vice Principal Dr. Anilkumar Wavare, Head, Department of Economics by paying virtual floral tribute to Padambhushan Dr.Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, Founder of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara. Dr.Anilkumar Wavare stated the aims and objectives of our parent institute, Rayat Shikshan Sanstha and explained the importance of higher education in India in glocal perspectives. DAY SECOND: (THURSDAY, 05/05/2022)


