

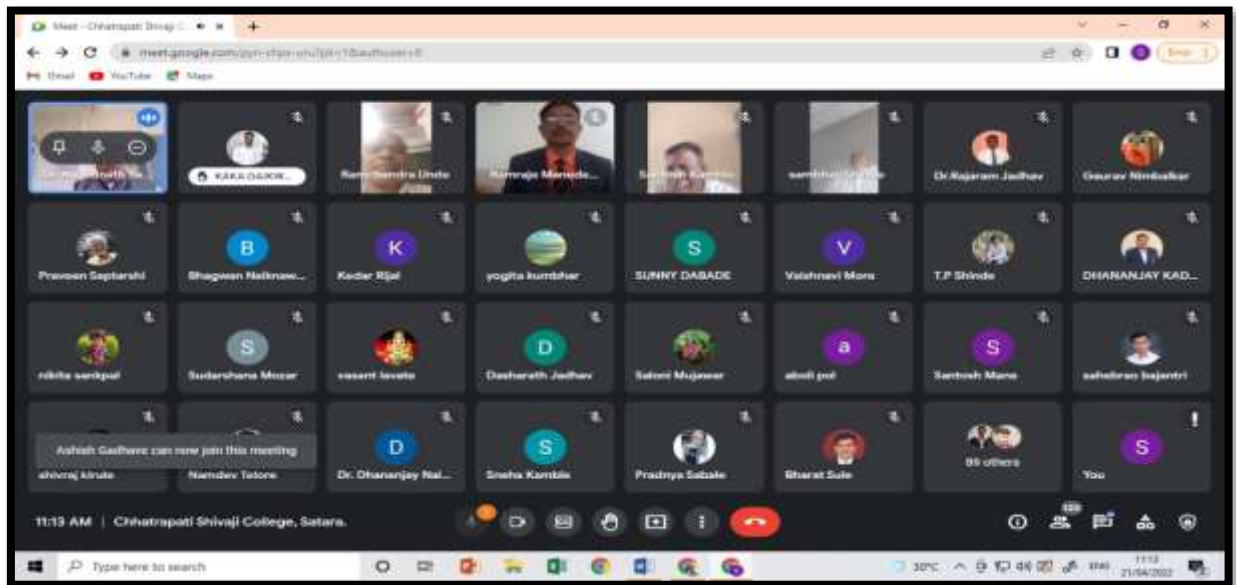

जोडलेले आहेत. आपत्तीमुळे समाज आणि समुदायांना आर्थिक नुकसान, पायाभूत सुविधांचा नाश आणि जीवितहानी होते. या संदर्भात आज जागतिक पातळीवर गांभीर्याने विचार होणे गरजेचे आहे. आज आपली व्यवस्थापनामध्ये भौगोलिक माहिती प्रणालीची भूमिका महत्त्वपूर्ण आहे. भूगोल हा समाज व विज्ञानातील सर्वसमावेशक अभ्यासातील महत्त्वाचा दुवा आहे. या माध्यमातून भौगोलिक आपत्तींना पाहता येते, समजून घेता येते. यानुसार भूगोलाच्या सुदूर संवेदन आणि भौगोलिक माहिती प्रणाली हे आधुनिक तंत्रज्ञानाकडे झुकवू लागले आहेत. उपग्रहाच्या मदतीने या आपत्ती स्थितीचे अध्ययन करणाऱ्या काळाची गरज आहे. या सत्राच्या अध्यक्षस्थानी मिरज महाविद्यालय मिरज येथील भूगोलशास्त्र विभाग प्रमुख प्रो. डॉ. एस. बी. गायकवाड उपस्थित होते.

आंतरराष्ट्रीय चर्चासत्रातील दुसऱ्या सत्रात प्रो. डॉ. कैदार रोजाल (नेपाळ) म्हणाले की, जगातील एवढीच परिसंस्थांमध्ये भारतीय हिमालयीन प्रदेशाचे विशेष स्थान आहे. भौगोलिकदृष्ट्या तरुण पर्वत श्रवणामानाच्या दृष्टिकोनातून आणि भारतीय उपखंडाच्या मोठ्या भागाला पाणी देणारे जीवन पुर्ववर्तीदार म्हणून महत्त्वाचे आहेत. तेथील आपत्ती व्यवस्थापनासाठी व्यापक दृष्टीने प्रयत्न होणे आवश्यक आहे. हिमालयात विविध प्रकारचे खनस्ती, प्राणी, मानवी समुदाय आणि सांस्कृतिक विविधता असलेली दिसते. तसेच तेथे विपुल नैसर्गिक संसाधने असूनही, तेथील बहुतेक लोक उपेक्षित आहेत आणि आज म्हणूनच त्याकडे शाश्वत विकासाच्या दृष्टीने सर्वांनी लक्ष देणे गरजेचे आहे. भूगोल



विषयाच्या अनेक उपशाखा आहेत. रिमोट सेंसिंग, जीआयएस, डिजिटल मॅनिंगमॅट यामाख्या क्षेत्रात भौगोलिक ज्ञान उपयुक्त ठरते. सध्या भारतत कोमल जल मॅनिजमेंटमध्ये देखील काम करण्याची संधी आहे. असेही त्यांनी सांगितले. या सत्राच्या अध्यक्षस्थानी कर्मवीर भाऊराव पाटील महाविद्यालय, पंढरपूर येथील भूगोलशास्त्र विभाग प्रमुख प्रो. डॉ. टी. एन. लोखंडे, उपस्थित होते.

आंतरराष्ट्रीय चर्चासत्राच्या शेवटच्या सत्रात अध्यक्षीय मनोगतात महाविद्यालयाचे उपप्राचार्य प्रो. डॉ. अनिलकुमार वाकरे म्हणाले की, आपली व्यवस्थापन आणि शाश्वत विकास कार्यक्रम वास्तविक-जगातील समस्यांचा शोध घेते. आज विद्यार्थ्यांना आणि राष्ट्रीय आणि आंतरराष्ट्रीय पातळीवर सर्वांना नैसर्गिक आपत्तीची संकल्पना आणि त्याचे शाश्वत निराकरण कसे करावे यासंदर्भातील कौशल्ये आज आत्मसात होणे गरजेचे आहे. आणि तशी कौशल्ये अशा चर्चासत्रातून प्राप्त होतील यात शंकाच नाही.
