REPORT

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Chhatrapati Shivaji College, Satara (Autonomous) conducted the Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on "New National Education Policy" (Interdisciplinary) between 25 April, 2022 to 30 April, 2022 in collaboration with UGC, Faculty Development Centre, HRDC, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune under the aegis of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA-2.0), Govt. of India, Component-8 Enhancing Quality and Excellence in Select Autonomous Colleges. Total 29 participants working in different colleges affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, University of Mumbai, Mumbai and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad participated in this Faculty Development Programme.

The Faculty Development Programme was commenced with inaugural function on Monday, 25 April, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. Prof. (Dr.) V.B. Jugale, Senior Economist and former Head and Professor, Department of Economics, Shivaji University, Kolhapur was the Chief Guest for the inaugural function of the FDP. Prin. Dr. Vitthal Shivankar, Secretary, Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara was the President of the inaugural function. Dr. Babasaheb Kangune, the Coordinator of the Faculty Development Programme delivered welcome speech and introduced the entire programme. The formal introduction of the Chief Guest and the President of the inaugural function was given by Dr. Babasaheb Kangune. The felicitation

programme of the dignitaries was conducted. In his inaugural speech, Prof. (Dr.) V.B. Jugale discussed on higher education in India. Prof. Dr. Anilkumar Wavare, Coordinator, IQAC and Vice Principal of the College focused on the importance of organizing such a FDP on New National Education Policy in his speech. The inauguration function ended with vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Subhash Karande, the Coordinator, RUSA, Chhatrapati Shivaji College, Satara.

After inauguration, Prof. (Dr.) V.B. Jugale, Senior Economist and former Head and Professor, Department of Economics, Shivaji University, Kolhapur conducted a session on 'Outcome Based Education' and its implementation. On the same day, after lunch Prof. (Dr.) Shivaji Sargar, Professor of English, University of Mumbai conducted two sessions namely 'Education of India: An Overview' and 'NEP 2020 and Higher Education'. In his sessions, he gave references of ancient Indian Universities like Nalanda and Takshashila imparting quality education. On the second day, Prof. (Dr.) S.S. Mahajan, Professor and Head, Department of Commerce, Shivaji University, Kolhapur conducted two pre-lunch sessions on 'Academic Bank of Credits' and 'Graduation Qualification Framework'. On 26 April 2022, Mr. Kishore Ingale, from TCS, Pune conducted two post-lunch sessions on 'Intellectual Property Rights-Academic Perspective' and 'Transforming Academic Libraries in view of New Education Policy'. Mr. Ingale conducted a group activity with the participants and collected their views regarding strengthening academic libraries.

In the entire Faculty Development Programme, Dr. Prashant Borkar, Vice President, Mastersoft Solutions, Nagpur conducted four sessions on two different days. In his sessions, Dr. Borkar discussed on 'Best Practices and Strategies for Accreditation Data Management', 'Institutional Preparedness for NIRF', 'Outcome Based Education: End to End Case Study' and 'Preparation for NAAC'. On Saturday, 30 April, 2022, Prof. (Dr.) Sanjeev Sonawane, Director, UGC, Faculty Development Centre, HRDC, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune conducted two interactive sessions on 'New National Education Policy'.


In this FDP, different activities were conducted in order to have the active participation of the participants. Participants were assigned work to make a list of POs, PSOs

and COs applicable to the programmes/ courses offered by their institutes. Besides, they were assigned to submit a report based on the discussions on NEP in the entire FDP on 'New National Education Policy'.
