#### **About the Department:**

With a view to open the vistas of higher education for the youths from the mofussil areas of Maharashtra the visionary educationist Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil inspired the college to start the UG department of English in 1954. Considering the need of higher education, the PG department was started in 1959. The Research Centre for M. Phil. started in 1985. Since its very inception the department is striving to educate and empower the rural youth.

The eminent alumni of the department like Barrister P. G. Patil, Prin. R. K. Kanbarkar, R. A. Kadiyal, brought glory to the department. The department has provided a good number of teachers of English to the Rayat Shilkshan Sanstha and also to Maharashtra. The eminent teachers and alumni like Dr. S. R. Suryawanshi, Prin. M. M. Swami, Prin. V. B. Saynakar, Prin. Mrs. Vijaya Patil, Mr. B. Devraj, Dr. A. B. Patil, Dr. M. A. Shaikh, Dr. Mrs. S.P. Chavan, Dr. S. R. Sawant, Sumant Jagtap, Dr. P. A. Attar etc. taught English language and literature and created a tradition of meritorious students in the area of Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

The department has conducted Short Term Courses of Communication Skills and Translation Skills for the better placements. The skill oriented short term course, 'Paper Jewellery is also conducted to provide small entrepreneurship skills. The publication of a wall magazine, *Golden Petals* has increased the involvement of students in creative and informative writing. The Winter Infotainment and Monsoon Infotainment programmes have created a healthy atmosphere among the fresher and senior students. A forum for enrichment of students' language skills is provided through the English Elocution and Poetry Recitation Competitions. The interdisciplinary lectures on various subjects have inspired students for the study of other subjects. Workshops and seminars have provided opportunities for participative learning. It has helped to inculcate the spirit of research among students. Students have shined in the subject merit list as well as the general merit list of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The department has followed the practice of enjoying the visits to theatre through the activity, 'Let's go to Theatre!' Every year the department has organized farewell functions. The department has conducted the courses for the study of foreign languages like Japanese and German to provide global exposure to students.

The department has organized two national seminars for faculty (March 2015 and September 2015). At present two faculty members are Ph. D. holders and two faculty members will soon be awarded the Ph. D. degrees. Dr. Mrs. Anisa Mujawar is a recognized guide for Ph. D. who has been working as a head of the department since 2007.


