About Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara:

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha is one of the largest and leading educational institutes in India founded by the eminent educationist and social reformer, Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil in the year 1919 at village Kale in Karad Tahsil.
