

The University is home to four distinct Schools, School of Computational Sciences, School of Humanities, School of Banking, Finance, and Management, School of Liberal Arts. Additionally, the University has established four chairs to promote various academic endeavors, Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Chair for Social Inclusion, Laxmibai Bhaurao Patil Chair for Women Empowerment, Chair for Financial Inclusion, Chair for Science for Sustainable Development.

About Chhatrapati Shivaji College, Satara:

Chhatrapati Shivaji College is the first College of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara, established in 1947 by the founder of the Sanstha, Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil. It was initially a free and residential college. The opening was a great social event as it would to provide higher education to the youths from the mofussil areas of Maharashtra. Karmaveer Anna opened this college as the first centre of higher education for poor and needy students. The college laid stress on a very novel kind of educational philosophy. The college introduced a unique 'Earn and Learn Scheme' for students to earn their education.

The college is the biggest single faculty Arts College. It imparts value education through conventional and non-conventional courses in languages and social sciences it also runs ten undergraduate and ten postgraduate programmes along with a Research Programme and several new self financing short term, University and Government courses on the campus.

The College has been accredited with 'A+' grade in the Third Cycle of accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangaluru, with a CGPA of 3.51 in 2017. The UGC, New Delhi, has conferred on the college autonomous status from the academic year 2019-2020. Under autonomy since 2019, the college has brought a change in the curricula by introducing various skills that are useful for employability. The College has celebrated its Platinum Jubilee.
